d. Focus on Grammar: The framework includes a focus on grammar, which is taught in a contextualized manner.

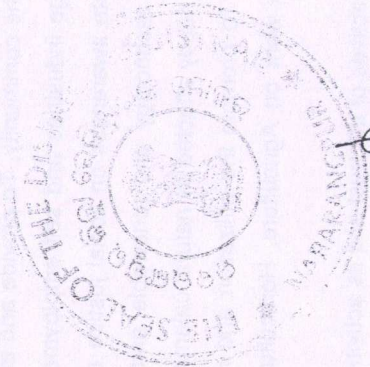
e. Assessment: The framework suggests a variety of assessment methods, including formative and summative assessments, to evaluate the students' progress.

4. CONSTITUTION OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees shall have as its members all Trustees whether appointed by this indenture or co-opted, with the PRESIDENT and Managing Trustee being the Trustees mentioned in the Article 4 above. PRESIDENT of the Board will preside over the meetings and conduct the proceedings. In his absence, any other Trustee chosen by the members attending the meeting will preside over that meeting.

5. POWERS OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES

1. Board of Trustees shall have the power to receive donations so as to augment the Trust Funds or to treat such donations for the purpose of the Trust either towards corpus or other funds eligible to be spent or applied according to the Objectives of the Trust.

2. Board of Trustees shall have the power to invest the funds in best possible manner with a view to augment the resources of the Trust to be able to better fulfill the Objectives of the Trust, but the Trust will not embark on any business or invest in any speculative venture. Such investments will also not deviate from the requirements of any law relating to Public Trusts or law relating to exemptions under section 11 to 13 of the Income-tax Act for income-tax and other direct tax laws.

3. The Trustees will be entitled to accumulate the income for the Objectives of the Trust and to apply the same either out of the funds or the income for purposes of the Trust to the extent considered prudent and necessary during the year subject to any regulations governing such accumulation under any law for the time being in force.

4. Board of Trustees shall open and operate one or more bank accounts as may be authorised by resolution to be operated by the Trust. The Board will have power to borrow, sign bills of exchange and cheques and authorise for this purpose any two of the Trustees or anyone of them along with Secretary or any other paid employee or nominee to exercise such power on its behalf by a Resolution.

5. Board of Trustees shall have power to convert the trust property, acquire immovable property, sell, charge, rent out or otherwise alienate the assets including immovable property for protecting or improving the Trust property or for any object of the Trust.

6. Board of Trustees shall have power to sue, defend suits and compromise them in the interest of the Trust in the name of the Trust.

7. Trustees will have powers to engage, suspend or dismiss employees or to take such other action to ensure proper management. It will have all powers necessary and incidental for management and administration of the Trust and its properties.


8. Board of Trustees shall have the power to delegate their duties to anyone of themselves or to employees, co-trustees and committees.


9. Board of Trustees may invite any employee, expert or well-wisher to attend Trust Board meeting for advice and participation without right to vote.

#### 6. FUNCTIONS

Without affecting the generality of powers and functions of the trustee/s to manage and administer the trust, the trustee/s shall have the following functions:

- (i) To borrow if need be against the security of the assets of the trust by way of bank overdraft, loan or otherwise, as may be necessary, for the benefit of the trust and for more effectively carrying out the Objectives and to bind the trust property for the purposes and enter into any agreement and sign such document authorising two or more of the trustees to execute such documents, deeds, papers, etc. as may be necessary in connection therewith.
- (ii) To arrange for and/or authorize the signing of or execution of any agreement, contract, instrument, document or any other paper or writing required to be signed or executed on behalf of the trustee/ s by any two of the trustees to be nominated in this behalf by a resolution at the meeting of the Board of Trustees and to make the same effective and binding as if the said agreement, contract, instrument or document or paper or writing were signed by all the trustees.
- (iii) To authorize anyone or more trustees to hold any property or any fund or any investment of the trust subject however to the terms of these presents in such manner and subject to such terms and conditions, rules and regulations as trustee/s may from time to time think fit and proper.
- (iv) To spend any portion of the corpus or the income of the trust for purchasing an land and/or constructing any building or buildings for and in the name of the trust for the purpose of carrying out promoting and/or executing any or all of the Objectives of the trust.

#### 7. OTHER INCIDENTAL POWERS

- (i) The trustees may invest the Trust funds either in immovable properties or in such manner as prescribed by these presents and as allowed by law as may be in force from time to time and to convert, alter, vary, dispose of or transfer such investments from time to time for better being able to conduct the affairs of the trust consistent with the Objectives of the trust.
- (ii) If the income from the trust property in a particular year is not fully utilized, the unexpended income subject to the applicable provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961 as may be amended from time to time or under any provision of Trust law or regulations governing such charitable institutions shall be carried over to the next year or years and spent in such subsequent year or years for the advancement of any of the object of the trust.
- (iii) The trustees shall be at liberty to sell such portion or portions of the movable or immovable properties forming part of the Trust Estate either by public auction or by private contract at such price or prices and in such terms and conditions relating to title or otherwise in all respects as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and to rescind or vary any contract for the sale thereof and to resell the same and to execute all conveyance or other assurances and to pass valid and effectual receipts and discharges for all moneys received by them.

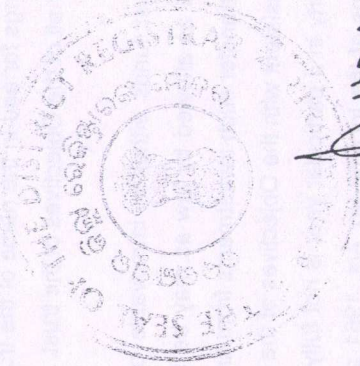

- (vi) The trustees shall maintain, improve and look after Trust property in a manner that is required with reference to the nature of the property. All other costs, charges and expenses incidental to the administration and management of the Trust Estate and the properties for the time being belonging to the trust may be incurred as they may in their absolute discretion think fit. The trustees will be entitled to reimbursement of any expenses which they may incur in respect of affairs of the trust.
- (viii) The trustees may appoint, employ or engage secretaries, managers, accountants, lawyers or others for the purposes of management and supervision of the Trust Estate for collection of rents, effects and profits, for keeping the accounts and records and for other purposes of the trust.
- (ix) The trustees may establish its office or function at such place or places and may change such places from time to time as they may think fit.
- (x) The trustees may demise the immovable property or properties for the time being and from time to time belonging to the trust either from year to year or for any fixed term or for any term of years or on monthly tenancies at such rent and subject to such covenants and conditions as may be considered proper and also accept surrenders of lease and tenancies and generally manage the same in such manner as may be considered reasonable.
- (xi) The trustees shall have full power to compromise or compound all actions, suits, and other proceedings and settle differences and disputes touching the trust Estate and/or the Trust properties and to refer any such differences or disputes to arbitration and to adjust and settle all accounts relating to the Trust Estate and/or the Trust Properties and to do all other acts and things fully or effectually without being liable or answerable for any bona fide loss occasioned thereby.
- (xii) The trustees may join, co-operate or work with any trust or institution in any joint program or activity upon such terms as they may in their absolute discretion think fit as long as it is done in a manner not inconsistent with the Objectives of the trust.

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(xiii) The trustees may from time to time frame schemes, rules and regulations for managing the affairs of the trust and for giving effect to the Objectives of the trust and may vary the schemes, rules and regulations from time to time as they may in their discretion deem necessary and proper. The receipts granted by the trustees or anyone or more of them for any moneys, stocks, funds, shares, securities or investments paid, delivered or transferred to them in exercise of the trust or powers hereof shall effectually release and discharge the person or persons paying, delivering or transferring the same.

8. TRUST BOARD:

**ROLES, RESPONSIBILITY AND POWERS OF THE TRUST BOARD MEMBERS:** The Roles, Responsibilities and powers of all these officers is defined below. In addition to these, the Managing Trustee may grant additional roles, responsibilities and powers to any of the Trustees.

a) **PRESIDENT:**

In addition to discharging normal duties of the Trust, the PRESIDENT shall preside over meeting. The PRESIDENT is authorized to sign Bank accounts, all documents, acknowledgements for the contributions received, and agreements with individuals, Government Institutions and other organizations, on behalf of the Trust. The PRESIDENT shall represent the Trust in all legal matters, sign the papers related to legal cases, attend to courts or represent the Trust in Government offices. The PRESIDENT shall have all the residuary powers, not explicitly assigned to any of the other officers in these presents.

b) **VICE PRESIDENT:**

The Vice PRESIDENT shall discharge the duties of the PRESIDENT, in the absence of the PRESIDENT of the Trust and shall have the power and authority delegated and assigned to him/her by the PRESIDENT.

c) **SECRETARY:**

The Secretary shall maintain the records of the organization prepare and circulate agenda and minutes of Board of meeting for the approval of the PRESIDENT.

The Secretary shall be also responsible for the day to day administration activities of the Trust. The Secretary shall deal with correspondence received by the Trust, send replies in consultation with the PRESIDENT, Vice PRESIDENT, and the Treasurer where necessary. He/she is responsible for the safe custody of all the properties and records of the Trust. He/ She will operate the bank account with the PRESIDENT.

Joint Secretary: The Joint Secretary shall discharge the duties of the Secretary, in the absence and shall have the power and authority delegated and assigned to him/her by the Trust Board.

e) **TREASURER:**

The Treasurer will prepare Annual Budget, monthly and yearly expenditure statements get the expenditure audited by auditor duly appointed by the Trust Board and place them for approval. The Treasurer is responsible to maintain cash book and prepare vouchers for the payments made, receive contributions, sign acknowledgements for the amounts or articles received by the Trust and prepare monthly and yearly statements of revenue and expenditure, as well as, the register of assets of the Trust and place them before Trust Board for their approval. The Treasurer is authorized to maintain petty cash and Books of accounts. The Treasurer is responsible for safe custody of cash, bonds, securities etc. of the Trust.

9. **DURATION OF THE TRUST:** The trust is irrevocable and will continue in perpetuity.

10. **AMENDMENT TO THE TRUST:** Provided that no amendments to the Trust deed, shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Sec.2(15), 11,12, 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. Further any amendment carried out shall be forthwith reported to the commissioner of Income Tax. Any kind of amendment in the Trust deed shall be made as per rules of the Trust Act.

11. **NO BENEFIT TO SETTLER, TRUSTEES AND OTHERS**

Trustee will not be entitled to any remuneration save right to reimbursement of expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties. Neither the settler, trustees nor their families, any member of their families, any of their relatives or concerns in which any of these persons are interested will be entitled to any benefit prohibited by Section 13 or otherwise directly or indirectly from the Trust.

12. **INDEMNITY FOR TRUSTEES**

Trustees will not be personally liable for any act bona fide done on behalf of the Trust in the course of duties as a Trustee.

13. **SUITS & PROCESSES**

The Managing Trustee may sue and be sued in the name of the Trust.

14. **MEETINGS**

The Board Meeting will be held, at least, once in three months, notice of such meeting being given, at least, a week in advance. Decisions will be taken as far as possible by consensus and in the event of any difference by majority. Where the votes are equal, the PRESIDENT will have the casting vote. There will be no quorum for such meetings. Resolution by circulation is permissible.

15. **ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT**

Accounts will be kept for the Trust and closed on every 31st March and such accounts shall also be audited by a qualified Chartered Accountant within six months from end of the accounting year.

16. **BANK ACCOUNT:**

The President and the Secretary shall jointly operate Bank Accounts on behalf of the Trust. One or more Bank Accounts may be opened in any Bank and or Banks in the name of the Trust

17. FUNDS:

MEMBERSHIP AND CONTRIBUTION:

1. 18. INVESTMENT OF FUNDS:

1. The Board of Trustees shall have the power to invest the funds, assets and properties of the Trust at their discretion in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
2. The Board shall also determine from time to time, the amount it shall spend on the various activities of the Trust.

19. SETTLER AND THEIR RELATIVES:

Notwithstanding the powers vested with the Trustees under the proceeding clause, no part of the income of the Trust shall benefit directly or indirectly the trustees and no part of the income of the property of the Trust shall be used or applied directly or indirectly for the benefit of:

1. SETTLER, Managing Trustee, Trustees or any person who makes a substantial contribution to the Trust or of any relative of the SETTLER, Managing Trustee, Trustees or the person who makes a substantial contribution.
2. Any "related concern" in which any of the above persons has substantial interest.
3. For the purpose of this clause, the word "relative" and the phrases "related concern", "substantial interest" and "substantial contribution" shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

20. APPLICABILITY OF TRUST ACT:

The provisions of the Indian Trust Act 1882 shall apply to all matters not specifically mentioned in these presents.

21. APPLICATION OF INCOME TAX ACT: All clauses herein are intended to secure exemption from Income Tax on the income of contributions and donations to the Trust and any clause or portion of this Deed of Trust which is inconsistent with or repugnant to the sections of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended, substituted or modified from time to time, shall be deemed to be deleted or modified with effect from the date on which the sections to which the clause or part of a clause is repugnant or inconsistent comes into force.

22. RECORD

23. SAVING CLAUSE

If the object or any of the powers or any provision in the Trust Deed is inconsistent with requirements of law relating to Public Trusts or Trusts eligible for exemption under the Income-tax Act, or any other direct tax law, such object, power or provisions will stand modified to the extent that they should accord with such law so as to continue to be eligible to be treated as a Public Charitable Trust.

24. RESOLVING DISPUTES

If thereby any doubt about interpretation of this Deed or about duties, the matter shall be referred to an arbitrator chosen by a consensus among the trustees and his decision shall be accepted.

25. DISSOLUTION

In case it becomes necessary to wind up or otherwise determine this Trust for whatever reason, neither the settlor nor his heirs not the Trustees for the time being nor any other person shall have any manner of right over such funds of the Trust or any other property.

The net funds and other assets, if any, after meeting all liabilities will be handed over to any other similar Trust or Institution similarly satisfying requirements of the Income-tax Act, 1961 as may be decided by the last Trustees subject further to the condition that it shall be so given to an Institution as approved by the Commissioner of Income-tax or Director of Exemptions as the case may be.
